MPH 510 - Environmental & Occupational Epidemiology

3 Credit Hours

The field of environmental and occupational health spans a broad range of topics, including the air we breathe and the water we drink to the physical injuries and mental challenges we may face in a work environment. The goal of this specific branch of epidemiology is to improve the health of vulnerable populations, by promoting practices and policies that reduce harmful exposures.
