

MFP 535 - Financial Statement Analysis

3 Credit Hours

The Financial Statement Analysis course focuses on the most salient aspects of accounting, analysis and security valuation. The course's objective is to teach students how to read, analyze and interpret financial statement data to make informed business decisions. MFP 535 is a foundational, core course in our Financial Planning program. The course covers seven modules: 1) Revenue Recognition, 2) Asset Recognition, 3) Liability Recognition, 4) Equity Recognition, 5) Analyzing Leases, Pensions and Taxes, 6) Cost of Capital, and 7) Cash Flow-Based Valuation.
