

LEA 707 - Women, Leadership, and Power

3 Credit Hours

This course examines challenges and opportunities that influence women's leadership development, the connection between leadership and power and the societal consequences to the underrepresentation of women in leadership positions. The course prepares students to be knowledgeable about the importance of women holding leadership positions, examines why women are underrepresented at all levels of decision-making, critique gender differences in power and leadership, and understand how intersectionality and leadership are related.
